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I am not a member of any church, denomination or religious organization.

I was raised in the Seventh-day Adventist Church. My father was a pastor. How fortunate I was to be in a family, and a denomination, that actually studied the Bible – in depth. I went to Seventh-day Adventist schools from the first grade through college. We studied the Bible in school, at home and at church. We were able to recite all the books of the Bible in order by the time we were 6 years old, which was very helpful when looking up Bible texts. Many adult Christians never learn how to do that.

We studied all the prophecies of Daniel and Revelation beginning at the age of 5. By the time I was 6 years old, I understood, from those prophecies that, in the future, there would be a One World Government, world-wide pandemics, famines and severe persecution for true Christians. That was 78 years ago. I just didn't know, when I was 6, that it would happen in my lifetime.

I literally grew up with the Beasts of Daniel and Revelation. My father, a pastor, gave Daniel and Revelation seminars regularly. This was before there were computers, power point, and even before slides. So, he had plywood cutouts made and painted, depicting the beasts of Daniel and Revelation, and the Three Angels of Revelation 14. When he wasn't using them for his preaching, they were stored in our garage at home. I was probably the only kid in America who had to "navigate" around the Beasts of Daniel and Revelation in order to get into the car.

But 30 years ago, in 1990, from reading the "inside" documents I had received, and from the events happening in the world, I <u>knew</u> that the One World Government **would**, **indeed**, **happen in my lifetime**.

I left the Seventh-day Adventist church when I was 21, and had my name taken off the books. Since that time, for the last 63 years, I have never been a member of any church or denomination. I left the church **because** - - - - I had such wonderful Christian parents. My parents were good and kind and loving. Yet, I was asked, by the church, to believe in **the same "God" that ALL Christian denominations believe in**: a "God" who says, "Love Me – and I'll let you live with Me for eternity. But if you don't, I'm going to burn you in hellfire FOREVER!"

I couldn't wrap my mind around a "god" like that. My parents, who were mere human beings, would NEVER do anything like that to me! They disciplined my brother and me when they felt we needed it, but I knew they would never really hurt us. And even if I

had become a serial killer, they would have hated what I had done, but they would still have loved me.

So, I wondered, "How could my parents be more loving than God?" I could NEVER actually LOVE a God who was going to burn me to death - or burn me forever - if I didn't love Him back. So, not wanting to be a hypocrite, I left the church – and ALL religion!



This picture was taken in 1941, when I was 4 years old. My father (center, front row), gave Daniel and Revelation seminars regularly. My mother (with dark hair) is sitting to my father's right. Notice the plywood cutouts of the Beasts of Daniel 7 in the lower right and left hand corners, and one above the "Three Angels" of Revelation 14.

I was an agnostic for 35 years, and never went to ANY church at ANY time.

But when I was dying of cancer, I knew I needed someone smarter than me to run my life, and I became a Bible-believing Christian. But I did **not** become a member of any

church or denomination nor have I been for the last **63 years**, nor do I even attend any church.

Christianity is NOT a religion. It is a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, with NO ONE in between.

I wrote a book that was published in January of 2020, the title of which is:

"Who Started the Organized Church? It Wasn't God! For the First 4,000 Years of Human History – NO ONE "went to church."

My book reveals that God did NOT start the Organized Churches. If God had wanted an organized church, He could have started it 500 years after creation, when there were plenty of people to "go to church." But He didn't!

Note: The Seventh-day Adventists believe ALL of the same doctrines that all of the other churches believe, with two exceptions: 1) they believe that the Seventh-day Saturday is the Sabbath that **God** made holy, and 2) they believe that when a person dies, he or she is dead in the grave until the resurrection (1st or 2nd resurrection) and does NOT go directly to heaven or hell.

Evidence for the State of the Dead: When you're Dead - - - You're DEAD! You don't know ANYTHING and you Don't go ANYWHERE! You are Dead in the Grave.

What Happens to a Person When He Dies?

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There are at least 25 Bible texts that tell us that death is a sleep, even Jesus, Himself said it was (John 11:11-13) and that when a person is dead, he remains in the grave and he has no thoughts. He is in a state of lack of consciousness. He knows NOTHING! He is not in heaven nor hell. He is in the grave and knows nothing.

1) For the living know that they will die, **BUT THE DEAD KNOW NOTHING**; they have no further reward, for even the memory of them is forgotten.

Also their love, and their hatred, and their envy, **is now PERISHED**; neither have they any share in anything that is done.

Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might, for in the grave, where you are going, there is neither working nor planning nor knowledge nor wisdom. Ecclesiastes 9:5

- 2) Turn, O Lord, and deliver me; save me because of your unfailing love. **No one remembers You when he is dead. Who praises You from the grave?** Psalm 6:4,5
- 3) And the Lord formed man of the DUST of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the BREATH of LIFE, and man became a living soul. Genesis 2:7 (The Creation of Man)
- 4) Do not put your trust in princes, in **mortal men**, who cannot save. When their breath departs, they return to the ground; **on that very day, their thoughts perish.**Psalm 146:3,4 (The Death of Man = the REVERSE of Creation: Their breath returns to God, their body returns to Dust, and their thoughts CEASE.)
- 5) Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was; and the breath shall return unto God Who gave it. Ecclesiastes 12:7
- 6) The **dead praise not the Lord**, neither any that go down into silence. Psalm 115:17

- 7) Jesus Christ...the King of kings and Lord of lords, **Who <u>ALONE</u>** is immortal. 1 Timothy 6:15,16
- 8) For the grave cannot praise You, death cannot sing Your praise; Isaiah 38:18
- 9) **The soul who sins, SHALL die.** Ezekiel 18:4 (It will NOT just change into another form.)
- 10) But the fruit of the tree in the middle of the garden, God has said "You shall NOT eat of it, neither shall you touch it, **or you will die!**" Genesis 3:3 (Eve is telling, Satan the Adversary who has taken the form of a serpent, what God has told Adam and Eve.)
- 11) And the serpent (Satan) said unto the woman: **"You will NOT surely die.** For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, **and you will become as gods**, knowing good and evil." Genesis 3:4,5

This is the **FIRST GREAT DECEPTION**; Satan said "If you sin, you WON'T die, instead you will become as gods!" This is still the theme, AND the continuing **DECEPTION**, of the New Age Religion!

John 11:11-14 Jesus compares death to sleep. The Bible compares death to sleep over 50 times.

Eccl. 9:5, 6, 10 The dead don't know anything.

Ps. 6:5 In death there is no remembrance of God.

Gen 2:7 Dust + Breath = A living soul (a person). This is the essence of creation. The soul is not a separate entity from the body.

Job 27:3 The Spirit is the same as God's breath of life or His power.

Ps. 146:4 Reverse of creation: Breath ceases, the body returns to dust and the thoughts (the essence of a living soul) perish.

Eccl. 12:7 The body returns to dust and the spirit (breath) returns to God.

Ps. 146:3,4 When the breath (spirit) returns to God, the thoughts perish.

Ps. 115:17 The dead do not praise God.

1 Cor. 15:51-54 We receive immortality when Jesus comes again.

Acts 2:34 David did not ascend to heaven at death, but awaits the coming of Jesus and

the first resurrection.

1 Tim. 6:16 Human beings do not have immortality, only God does.

Job 19:25,26 The righteous will be resurrected to see God at the Last day.

John 5:28,29 Where are the people who come forth in the resurrection? They are now in the graves.

Rom 6:23 The wages of sin is death.

Ezekiel 18:4 The soul (person) who sins will die.

1 Tim. 4:7,8 The apostle Paul waited the coming of the Lord for his final reward.

Gen. 3:3,4 The first great deception: "You won't die!"

John 14:2,3 "I go to prepare a place for you. And I will come to get you and take you where I am." Why does He have to come and get them if they are already in heaven?

1 Thess 4:16-18 Why do the righteous dead have to rise at the resurrection if they're already in heaven?

Acts 17:31 The world will be judged on an "appointed day." You can't go to heaven until God makes a judgment on your case. Obviously it doesn't happen when each person dies.

Rev. 20:12 Why is there a FUTURE judgment if everyone is already in heaven or hell? They must have been "judged" already on an individual basis at the moment they died. But that is not Biblical (see previous text).

Rom. 2:7 Why do we "seek for immortality" if we already are immortal?

John 11:23,24 Mary and Martha were Jesus' closest friends on earth, other than His disciples. What was their understanding about where Lazarus was in death and when he would be resurrected?

John 11:43,44 If Lazarus was already in heaven why would Jesus resurrect him back to this earth? That would be cruel!

John 20: 11-18 Jesus did NOT go to heaven immediately at death!

What Day Did God Make Holy?

1) Genesis 2:1-3

"Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.

"And on the Seventh day God ended His work which He had made: and He rested on the Seventh day from all His work which He had made.

"And God BLESSED the Seventh day and sanctified it (made it holy): because that in it He had rested from ALL His work which God created and made."

2) The Fourth Commandments (Exodus 20:8-11) The Sabbath is a MEMORIAL of Creation

"Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

"Six days thou shalt labor and do all they work, but the Seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God; in it thou shalt not do ANY work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gate (anyone working for you)

"For in six days the Lord made the heaven and the earth and all that in them is, and rested the Seventh day; wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it (made it holy)."

3) The Fourth Commandment repeated (Deuteronomy 5:12-15) The Sabbath is a Memorial of the Redemption of the World

"Keep the Sabbath day to sanctify it (keep it as a holy day), as the Lord thy God has commanded thee

"Six days thou shalt labor and do all thy work

"But the Seventh day is the Sabbath; in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, nor thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thine ox, nor thine ass, nor any of thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates; that thy manservant and thy maidservant may rest as well as thou

"And remember that you were a servant in the land of Egypt (symbolizing sin) and that the Lord thy God brought thee out (symbolizing redemption)

thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm; therefore the Lord they God commanded thee to keep the Sabbath day."

4) Was the Seventh-day Sabbath done away with at the cross? (Colossians 2:14)

"Blotting out the handwriting of ORDINANCES (the "Sabbath days" that ended each of the feasts – termed the Ordinances – that were fulfilled with the birth, death and resurrection of Christ) that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross."

"Let no man therefore judge you in meat (the word is "food" – including "food" sacrificed to idols), or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon or of the Sabbath days. (The feast days – ORDINANCES – were designated by the month – which was designated by the NEW MOON. The Saturday Sabbath was NOT. IT came every week – every Seventh day.)

This verse is clearly talking about the "Sabbaths" that came at the end of each feast, NOT the Seventh-day Sabbath which was part of the Ten Commandments, written by God with His OWN finger in stone – to show their permanence.

The word "Sabbaton" (meaning Sabbath – the Seventh-day, Saturday, Sabbath) appears 68 times in the New Testament. Fifty-nine times it is properly translated as Sabbath. But NINE TIMES, it is arbitrarily and incorrectly CHANGED to "first day of the week."

Sunday, the first day of the week, was made "holy" by a "man" – the Pope! But a human being CANNOT make a day "holy." Only God can!

Challenge: If anyone can show me, from anywhere in the Bible – in the ORIGINAL Hebrew or Greek - that the words "first day of the week" or the word "Sunday" EVER appear in the Bible, or that God made ANY day "holy' other than the Seventh-day, Saturday Sabbath, I would be happy to reconsider my position.

Universal Restoration

Biblical Proof that God Will SAVE ALL, AFTER they have reaped what they have sown.

1) In the parable of the lost sheep, how long did the shepherd search for the lost sheep? Until the sheep died from exposure to the elements? Until the shepherd got tired of searching, or until he wanted to move on to do something else? Of course not.

Answer: He searched until HE FOUND IT!

In the parable of the lost coin, how long did the woman search for the lost coin?

Answer: Until SHE FOUND IT!

Both the sheep and the coin were found. Why do we have two such similar parables? Answer: The sheep, a live animal, KNEW it was lost, and was subsequently found. But the coin, an inanimate object, was found when it DIDN'T even know it was lost!

Being "lost" does not necessarily mean "being deprived of life." The coin never had "life." Being "lost" is the prelude to being "found." When you are "lost" – you are "waiting to be found" (whether or not you understand it).

- 2) God has said "I will NEVER leave you nor forsake you." Heb. 13:5 But yet we're told that God's going to eventually destroy permanently about 75% of ALL the people in the world!!!! If that's not forsaking us, then what is?
- 3) Luke 19:10 Jesus said "For the Son of Man is come to seek and TO SAVE that which was lost." (And since everyone has no choice but to be born a sinner, then everyone is included in the term "lost"!) And Jesus said He came to SAVE them, NOT just to "offer" salvation to them -- but TO SAVE them!!!
- 4) John 12:47 Jesus said "For I came not to judge **the world**, but TO SAVE IT." (the WHOLE world)
- 5) Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded that NEITHER **DEATH**, nor life nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, NOR ANY OTHER CREATURE (including Satan) CAN SEPARATE US FROM THE LOVE OF GOD WHICH IS IN CHRIST JESUS OUR LORD!" So that means that **Death** INCLUDING the SECOND death CANNOT separate us from God!!
- 6) Eccl. 3:11 "He makes EVERYTHING beautiful IN ITS TIME."

- 7) Rev. 21:5 "Behold, I make ALL new."
- 8) 1 Timothy 4:10 "God is the Savior of ALL Mankind: ESPECIALLY (not ONLY) those who believe" (those who 'have faith' who believe without seeing the Greek word *pistis*).
- 9) 2 Cor 5:19 "God was in Christ, Reconciling THE WORLD to Himself. . ."
- 10) Luke 9:56 "For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to SAVF them."
- 11) Galatians 6:7 "Do not be deceived; God will not be mocked. Whatsoever a man sows, that shall he also reap."

Could YOU be happy for eternity if even ONE of your children was burning continuously in hellfire?

The Bible says we are made "in the image of God" (Gen 1:26) – so how could God be happy for eternity if even ONE of HIS children was burning continuously in hellfire?

Universalism is the false doctrine that God will save everyone just the way they are, without any changes in their life. That would mean that heaven and the New Earth would be just like the world is today.

I do NOT believe in "Universalism."

Universal Restoration is the TRUE Doctrine that God will Save **Everyone** He has ever created, but only AFTER they have reaped what they have sown and finally recognize their need for Jesus Christ to run their life. **Then** God will RESTORE everyone to what He designed them to be.

I DO believe in Universal Restoration - - because

"Nothing is impossible with God."
Luke 1:37
